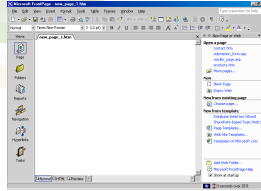

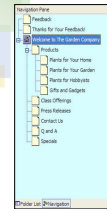

Navigation Pane Showing Web Site Structure



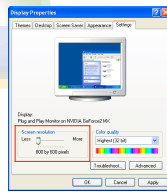

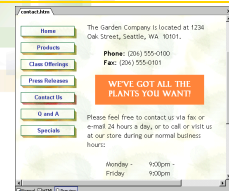
